The fruit of "racing" lines, BORN FREE inherits the strength, good bone structure and kindness of his Sire, as well as the chic and light movement of his Dam, herself the fruit of the Swedish-Polish bloodlines, Probat & Bask. With his great shoulder and powerful hind, his gait is extended and ample. BORN FREE provides an interesting alternative to the Persik and Dormane lines commonly used in France. His offspring, the eldest aged 7 in 2023, are lighter in build, inheriting his fine coat, his strength and his energy on the track. BORN FREE sadly departed far too early, but his frozen semen is still limitedly available (European quality).

His Sire NABATH, exported to Spain, is one of the highest performance-indexed French endurance stallions (173) having qualified 6 x 3*. His offspring is also proven: Aigoual Dimhah (2x2*, 2x3* & 7 y-o W.Ch. Samorin 4* 2014), Djoba de Luriecq (4x2* incl. 1 win 2015, 2x3* & participation in WEG 2018 for Switzerland), Selif de la Nie (2x2*, 5x3* incl. 3 wins & 5th EU.Ch. 4* Samorin 2015), Shaolin Roc'Hellou, stallion (3x2* & 3x3*), Taiga de Cammas (6x2* & 1x3* TOP5 Florac 2021), Un Dia (3x2* & 2 TOP5 3*), Up To You Art (3x2* & 1 podium Fontainebleau 3* 2018), Upedro (4x2* incl. 2 wins & 2x3* incl. 1 win), Uva du Cambou (6x2* incl. 2 podiums & 2x3* incl. 1 win & 1 TOP5), Bambou de Perros (2 Top5 2* UAE 2022).

His Dam WMA RACHAEL raced on the flat in America (\$72,469 - twice winner in sprint races and twice nominated for the "Darly Awards"), then in UAE where she won again. Of her 17 offspring, some raced on the flat (e.g. Rampart in England), others competed in endurance (e.g. Chador CEIYJ*** Oviedo 2008, Review de Sommant (2*), Tel Quel de Sommant (2 x 2* exported), U'N'Me de Sallaz (2* exported), Vikitikitavi d'Sallaz (2x3* incl. 1 podium in Santa Susana 2x100km 2019), Sallaz Cooky Crumbles (2* Fontainebleau 2021, then 7th 100km Kuwait 01/2023), Abracadabra de Sallaz (6x2* incl. 1 win Barre des Cevennes 2019 & 1 podium Kuwait 2022, and 1x3* Top10 Florac 2019, dam of Sallaz Flaming Blue (Top5 CEI1* Norway 2022)). Also, Scusi de Sommant (qualified 1*, dam of Avanti de Sommant - 1x2* & 2x3* 2018 & 2022).

His first daughter, Sallaz Golly Gosh 2016, qualified 80km in 2022.
