Winner of the Qatar Total French Arabian Breeders' Cup **G1-PA**, Coupe de France des Chevaux Arabes **G1-PA**, Qatar Derby **G1** and the Doha Cup - German Derby.

AL MAMUN MONLAU (MUNJIZ x SALALAH DE MONLAU) a Gr1-PA winner at 3 and 5-years-old, AL MAMUN MONLAU proved a most consistent performer throughout his racing career, cumulating over €300,000. Losing his maiden tag in the Qatar Total Arabian Trophy des Poulains Gr1-PA on Arc week, he scored on his seasonal return in the Coupe du Sud Ouest des Purs Sang Arabes Gr3-PA. At 5 he scooped up two Gr1s including the coveted Dubai Kahayla Classic at Meydan as well as the President Of The UAE Cup-Coupe d'Europe des Chevaux Arabes
